


How do I add an email address to Badgr or change my primary email?

In your [Badgr.io](#) account, you can change your primary email address or add additional email addresses. This allows you to upload badges you have earned from a variety of locations that may have been awarded to you via alternate email addresses (e.g., your school email).

Each Open Badge is awarded to a specific email address, and each email address must be added to Badgr (and verified by you) if you wish to upload to those badges to Badgr.

To add an email address to Badgr

1. In your [Badgr.io](#) account, select **Account** in the upper right menu, then select **Profile** from the dropdown menu.
